

Overview of Policies, Services, and Fees

Thank you for seeking services at *Skinner Psychological Services*, *PLLC*. This document is meant to serve as a general reference; however, detailed procedures are formally documented within relevant consent forms that require signature prior to commencement of services. Please note that the information contained in this document is subject to change at any time and, thus, should always be confirmed with your clinician.

Practice Policies:

- Alyson H. Skinner, PhD (Owner/Director) is a New York State licensed psychologist, subject to the local and federal laws governing practice of psychology. All associates, including administrative assistants, contractors, and clinicians-in-training, are also bound to regulations stipulated by their respective licensing boards and codes of professional ethics.
- All correspondence should be directed to the telephone number and/or email address
 provided in the footer of this page, unless otherwise specified by your treating clinician.
 Efforts are made to check all messages once per morning and evening of each business
 day, at minimum. Due to the nature of clinical practice and triage, every effort will be made
 to respond to inquiries within 1-2 business days following receipt.
- In order to employ an informed approach to consultative, evaluative, and therapeutic services, certain details and documents may be requested upon intake and/or throughout the course of service provision. Failure to produce these materials may delay scheduling of appointment(s) and/or necessitate rescheduling pending their receipt and review.
- Appointments are typically scheduled Monday-Thursday between the hours of 10:00am and 7:00pm. Additional time slots may be available for particular services (e.g., assessment, educational consultation), in extenuating circumstances, if previously agreed upon, or when indicated by your treating clinician.
- Clients are responsible for full payment at time of service, except when indicated below or mutually agreed otherwise. Cash, check, and major credit cards are accepted as forms of payment.
- Dr. Skinner and associates at Skinner Psychological Services, PLLC do not currently
 participate on managed care panels due to constraints imposed by insurance providers that
 are incompatible with our commitment to individualized and comprehensive standards for
 treatment services. Please check with your provider to determine eligibility for out-of-network
 coverage and reimbursement. A detailed invoice will be provided for all sessions that outline
 services rendered and contain diagnostic and procedural codes required for submission of
 claims. In instances of financial hardship, sliding scale fees may be offered at clinician
 discretion.
- Notice of cancellation must be provided at least 24 hours in advance of any scheduled appointments. Missed sessions will be subject to a <u>full fee</u> charge, except under extenuating circumstances.
- Unless otherwise indicated through formal agreement, clinicians at *Skinner Psychological Services*, *PLLC* do <u>not</u> provide crisis management and cannot guarantee immediate availability. All clients should call 9-1-1 or go to their nearest hospital if an emergency or any threat to personal safety should arise.
- In order to most effectively address client needs, all services and corresponding terms are individually structured. Please contact Skinner Psychological Services, PLLC or your treating clinician directly to address any questions or concerns regarding the information contained in this document.

Written Report Format: A written report is produced as documentation of all evaluative services, unless otherwise discussed and agreed upon by client and clinician. Dependent upon reason for referral, intended use for report, and/or personal preference, one of two formats for the written report may be selected. The components typically included in each are listed below for reference; however, reports may vary based on type of evaluation and case-by-case circumstances. The evaluating clinician reserves the right to clinical judgment in determining structure and content of information included in the written report. Clients should consult directly with clinician at outset of services to determine most appropriate format.

- The <u>abbreviated written report</u> provides a brief summary of background information, review of findings, and basic recommendations. Descriptions of instruments administered and corresponding tables of scores are typically provided in an appendix.
- The <u>comprehensive written report</u> provides detailed background information, review of relevant records (if applicable), descriptions of each instrument and scores obtained, formulation and implication of findings, detailed recommendations, and individualized resources.
